



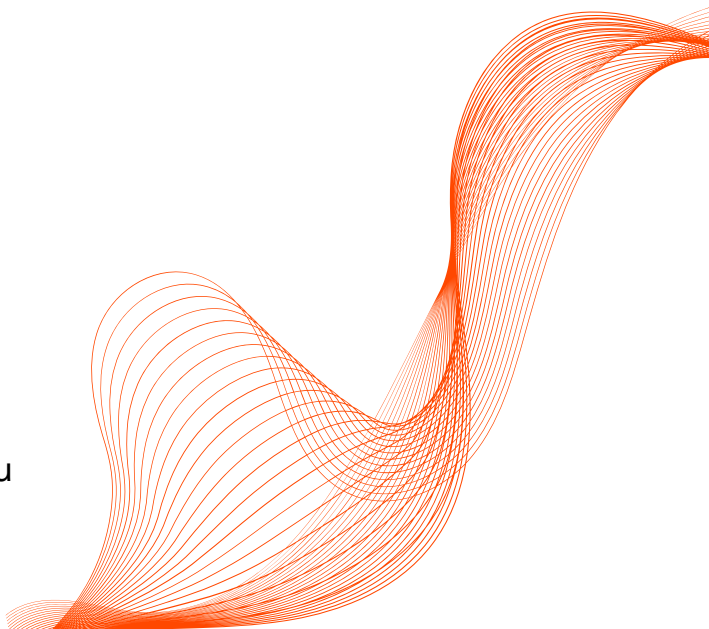

An Implementation Agenda

Connected technology is now critical infrastructure. From water networks to hospitals, from smart homes to connected consumer products. Sensors, data and connectivity underpin how Australia operates. Yet adoption remains fragmented, security concerns persist, and businesses struggle to find trusted guidance.

For close to a decade, the Alliance has existed to solve this. We're the independent body where competing interests collaborate, where government listens, and where practical guidance emerges.

In 2025, we won the federal government contract to build Australia's Security Labelling Scheme for Smart Devices, ushering in a new era of national security for connected technology and accelerating a trust agenda for the technology sector.

Our Priorities

Our members include Australia's leading technology providers, major utilities, universities, and industry bodies. We work directly with government agencies responsible for the nation's digital security.

And the work we do in implementing projects and developing products is focused on three priority areas:

Trusted Technology - Trust is the cornerstone of the digital economy, and this work focuses on security, privacy, governance and transparency standards.

Connected Systems and Data - This work on connected technology convergence is essential, tackling the fundamentals of connectivity, sensing, and data analytics.

Industry Transformation - At a time when provocative and forward-thinking action is essential, the Alliance draws on the expertise of its members to identify opportunities related to physical AI, automation, smart consumer products, digital twins, advanced computing, and workforce capability.

Application

Contact the Alliance team to discuss and confirm your preferred package. Sponsorship acceptance is subject to Alliance approval and includes consideration of alignment with the Summit program and the Alliance's values and objectives.

Cancellation

Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing. 50% of the contracted amount is retained for cancellations made more than two months prior to the Summit. 100% is retained for cancellations less than two months prior. If the event is cancelled due to a pandemic or disaster, the Alliance will negotiate deferral to a future event.

Promotions and Marketing

Sponsors are required to provide high-resolution logos, organisation bios, and relevant information by deadlines specified by the Alliance. The Alliance will not be responsible for publishing materials submitted after a deadline or in an incorrect format.

Obligations and Rights

The Alliance reserves the right to amend sponsorship packages where necessary to benefit the sponsor or the Summit experience. Sponsors must ensure their promotional activities do not interfere with other sponsors.

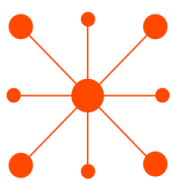
